Former Equalities Minister Helen Grant MP is bringing together Church Leaders and worshippers in an EU remain presentation at the CFT Cathedral, Ebenezer Building, 186 Powis Street, Woolwich London SE18 6NL here: <http://bit.ly/1UhUK6k>



The event will focus upon how BME communities may be affected by the referendum decision.

Speaking alongside Mrs Grant at the event will be TV broadcaster June Sarpong MBE, Operation Black Vote Director Simon Wooley, Shadow Minister for Energy Clive Lewis MP and the leader of Christ Faith Tabernacle International Churches - Apostle Alfred Williams.

The event has attracted around 30 prominent Church Leaders as well as a large number of church-goers with attendance likely to be in the order of 2000 or more people. **Members of the public wishing to attend the service and the EU Remain presentation at 8pm are welcome.**

Media are invited to attend from 7:15pm. A pre-service reception for Church Leaders and other VIPs will take place at the CFT Cathedral from 7:30pm before the service commences at 8:00pm. The referendum presentation will form a part of the service proceedings which will end at 9:30pm following which the speakers will be mingling to answer informal questions.
